This includes artist mentors visiting schools to host workshops and create murals building creativity and connection among students and teachers. Additionally, organizations come to ACG asking to host arts programming for them in Art.Work.Space. They see Albany Center Gallery as their community arts space, and we want them here. Since the opening of Art.Work.Space. and its associated in-house workshops, two dozen workshops have been hosted ranging in diverse mediums from painting and collaging to creative expression through intuitive movement and nature.
